

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

In order to participate in the Kohl's Cares program, participants must meet the following requirements:

1. Live in Rhode Island
2. Receive financial assistance (e.g. WIC, food stamps, NHPRI)
3. Be expecting a child or have children under 80 pounds
4. Own a car or consistently use a family member/friend's car
5. Must attend a one hour educational workshop

Qualifying participants should contact the number listed below if they are interested in the program.

Families who do not qualify but who already own a car or booster seat should have it checked to ensure proper installation. Please contact the Injury Prevention Center or your local police station to schedule an appointment.

ABOUT KOHL'S CARES CAR SEAT
CHECK PROGRAM

Car crashes are the number one killer of children under 14 years of age. Many of these deaths and related injuries could be avoided by properly using a car or booster seat. Unfortunately, even when caregivers place their children in safety seats, they often do not install the seat correctly.

Kohl's Cares Car Seat Check Program is designed to increase awareness and proper usage of child passenger safety seats. Qualifying families must attend a one hour bilingual education workshop to learn about child safety seats. After attending the workshop, participants will receive an appointment for a free car seat check. When necessary, we will provide car seats to qualifying families free of charge.

CAR SEAT GUIDELINES

*** Type of Seat: Infant only or rear facing convertible**

- * Requirements: Birth to 1 year *and* at least 20 pounds
- * Seat Position: Rear facing in the back seat

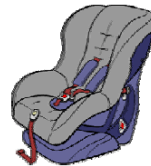
REAR FACING

*** Type of Seat: Forward facing or convertible**

- * Requirements: Over 1 year and 20-40 pounds
- * Seat Position: Forward facing in the back seat

CONVERTIBLE

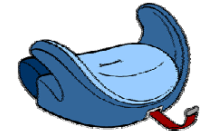


CAR SEAT GUIDELINES, cont...

*** Type of Seat: Belt positioning booster seat**

- * Requirements: 40-80 pounds and under 4'9"
- * Seat Position: Forward facing in the back seat
- * Notes: Booster seats must be used with both lap and shoulder belts. Do not allow children to place seat belts under their arms or behind their backs.

*** Type of Seat: Seat belt**

- * Requirements: After age 8 or taller than 4'9"
- * Seat Position: Children under 12 years old must ride in the back seat
- * Notes: Adults should be role models for their children and buckle up every time they travel in a car or truck!
